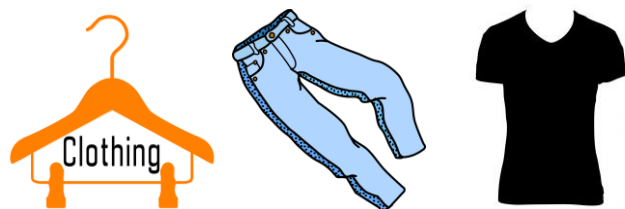


April 2024
