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Student Fees – reminder that Student Fees were due on the first day of school. If you have not paid your child's student fee and need to make arrangements to set up a payment plan, please contact the office.

Online payments for student fees are the preferred method of payment.

Elementary student fees are \$50.

Middle Level and High School student fees are \$40.

If student fees are not paid, the money for the school supplies, co-curricular, extra-curricular activities must come from the school's regular budget. This then takes away from money available for general classroom supplies, office supplies, school furniture, specialized Resource and Guidance supplies like wiggle chairs, art supplies, science supplies, library books, locks for lockers, special prizes and medals, classroom technology, classroom toys, playground equipment and general upkeep of the school.

Please contact school if you need to make special arrangements to pay your child's student fees. Not paying student fees directly impacts the children as we are not able to offer everything that we usually do because we do not have the funds.
